Non-Exclusive License Agreement for Access to the Ophthalmic News & Education (ONE ™) Network

This License Agreement ("Agreement") is made and entered into this June 2011, ("Effective Date"), by and between the American Academy of Ophthalmology, a San Francisco, CA, not-for-profit corporation with its principal address at 655 Beach Street, San Francisco, California 94109, United States of America ("Licensor"), and the Turkish Republics Ophthalmology Society (TROS) ("Licensee").

WHEREAS, Licensor is a tax-exempt corporation whose purposes include advancing medical science and patient care in the field of ophthalmology;

WHEREAS, Licensor is the owner or licensee of certain original works of authorship which are protected by law, including copyright; and

WHEREAS, Licensor desires to grant to Licensee a limited license to use certain of said works for the purposes set forth below, and Licensee desires to receive said grant of license.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants set forth in this Agreement, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. Grant of License and Ownership Rights.

- **1.1 Grant of License.** Licensor grants to Licensee a non-exclusive, non-transferable, limited license for the Licensee to provide access to all ophthalmologists in Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, Kyrghizistan, Northern Cyprus, Uzbekistan and Turkmenistan ("Licensee Ophthalmologists") to Licensor's cobranded online portal ("Online Portal") for access to the Ophthalmic News & Education (ONE ™) Network (collectively, "Licensed Works"). *This Licensee grant applies only to rights described below (the "Permitted Use")*.
- **1.2 Permitted Use.** For the term of this Agreement, Licensee is granted permission to provide Licensee Ophthalmologists with online access to the Licensed Works. The online access shall be for a period of two years from the date the Licensor gives access to the ONE Network Online Administrative Tool.
- **1.3 Internet Access Limitations.** Licensee's link to Licensor as permitted herein permits Licensee Ophthalmologists to have online access to the Licensed Works for their own professional, noncommercial use, provided, however, that Licensee shall include the following statement as part of Licensor's copyright notice:

"Ophthalmologists in Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, Kyrghizistan, Northern Cyprus, Uzbekistan and Turkmenistan are allowed to use the materials on Licensor's Ophthalmic News & Education (ONE ™) Network Web site ONLY, for their own professional, noncommercial use."

Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the parties agree and acknowledge that said Licensee does not include a license to publish, distribute, alter or modify the content of the Licensed Works in any way.

- **1.4** Acceptance of and Compliance with Terms of Service: Licensee agrees that use of the Licensed Works is governed by the Terms of Service ("TOS") on the Ophthalmic News & Education (ONE™) Network site, attached hereto as Exhibit A, and that violation of the TOS by a user will result in termination of that user's access to the Licensed Works.
- **1.5 Licensee Access:** Licensee agrees to provide access to ophthalmologists in their country and/or region through uploading a list of the individual's name and e-mail address into the Licensed Work.
- **1.6 Licensor's Ownership Rights Reserved.** The parties agree and acknowledge that Licensor owns all right, title and interest in and to Licensed Works, or has a valid and current license to use such works. No title to any of the Licensed Works or ownership of related intellectual property rights is transferred from Licensor to Licensee hereunder.
- **1.7 Organization Logo:** Licensor may cobrand the initial e-mail access announcement with Licensor and Licensee logo, the International Council of Ophthalmology's logo, as well as the logo of local and/or regional participating societies/organizations. Licensee's logo will not appear in the Licensed Works for purpose of this agreement.

2. License Fees.

- **2.1 Licensee.** In further consideration of the obligations of Licensee herein, Licensee shall not pay any fees.
- **2.2 Limitation on Licensee Ophthalmologists.** Licensee shall be entitled to provide access to its verified Licensee Ophthalmologists in the country/region. Access to the Licensed Works will end coterminous with the end of the Term of this Agreement, unless the parties agree to an extension.
- **3. <u>Promotion.</u>** If Licensee so desires, Licensor will provide Licensee with promotional materials. Materials may be revised for direct translations and local language variations; however, any revisions will require advance approval from Licensor.

Licensee agrees to promote Licensed Works to ophthalmologists in the country/region at least eight times during the term of the Agreement, using its publications, e-mail announcements, mailings or other regular communications with ophthalmologists in the country/region. Licensor also agrees to promote Licensed Works at any and all of its meetings. Licensee will send Licensor a copy of promotional items.

If Licensee desires, Licensor will support the promotional efforts by e-mail blasting the promotional materials to Licensees Ophthalmologists. There is no charge to Licensee for this service.

4. Term and Termination.

- **4.1 Term of Agreement.** This Agreement shall commence as of the date of Licensee signing this Agreement for the Licensed Works and receiving access to the ONE Network Online Administrative Tool, unless earlier terminated in accordance with the terms hereof, shall continue and remain in full force and effect for 24 months from the Effective Date. At that time Licensee may apply for renewal of this license for online access for ophthalmologists in the country/region. The access prices for Licensee and Licensee Ophthalmologists are not guaranteed to stay the same for such renewal terms.
- **4.2 Rights and Remedies upon Material Breach; Right to Cure.** Upon the occurrence of a material breach by a party, the non-breaching party shall give notice of such material breach to the breaching party, and the breaching party shall have one (1) opportunity to cure such breach within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of such notice. Upon the breaching party's failure to timely cure such breach, the non-breaching party shall be entitled to: (a) terminate this Agreement, and (b) seek to recover from the breaching party damages and any other relief at law or in equity that the non-breaching party may deem appropriate.
- **5.** <u>Assignment</u>. This Agreement may not be assigned by either party without the prior written consent of the other.
- **6.** <u>Severability</u>. The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of this Agreement shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision.
- 7. <u>Waiver of Breach</u>. No waiver on behalf of any party of any breach of the provisions of this Agreement shall be effective or binding on such party unless the same shall be expressed in writing, and any waiver so expressed shall not limit or affect such party's rights with respect to any future breach of any of the provisions of this Agreement.
- 8. Governing Law; Exclusive Jurisdiction. This Agreement shall be deemed to have been made, executed, and delivered in the city of San Francisco, in the State of California, and all the rights and duties of the parties arising from or relating in any way to the subject matter of this Agreement or the transaction(s) contemplated by it shall be governed by, construed, and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of California, without regard to California's conflict of laws statute. Any suit or proceeding relating to this Agreement, including arbitration proceedings, shall be brought only in San Francisco County, California. Both parties consent to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of the courts, state and federal, located in San Francisco, San Francisco County, California.
- **9. Entire Agreement; Modification.** This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof, and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, understandings, negotiations, and discussions, whether oral or written, between the parties with respect to the subject matter of this Agreement. There are no representations, undertakings, or agreements of any kind between the parties respecting the subject matter hereof except those contained in this Agreement. This Agreement may be modified only pursuant to a writing executed by authorized representatives of the parties.
