This society is a legal non-governmental organization, consisting of ophthalmologists from different countries that are fundamentally similar to each other in terms of language, culture, and some common historical background.

Indeed, a legislation was created in order for non-governmental organizations to have legal properties in which this society was perfected. This process was carried out in line with the laws of Turkish Republic, while ophthalmologists from other countries applied and became members of this society established with "international characteristics".

This society was essentially planned to be an association-confederation, where the ophthalmology societies of every country congregate, with the hope that this structure might come true in the coming years.

The main aim of this society to hold meetings and share scientific results among members, communicate for educational purposes, and increase our members' occupational knowledge, skills and scientific participation by ensuring positive cooperation opportunities with other international societies in the absolute scientific framework of the field of ophthalmology. Beside holding international scientific meetings in TROS member countries, also TROS scientific activities are held in TROS members' locally held national or international congresses by their invitation.

To that end, TROS conducts scientific meetings in different countries and enables information exchange. In this field, Turkish Ophthalmology Society (TOS) supplies limited yet some financial contributions which allows a certain quota for TOS National Congress events, where ophthalmologists, members of TROS, from different countries are invited to take a role in scientific activities.

Thanks to the scientific communication and participation of its members who expand to an extensive geography, TROS seeks to fulfill the scientific needs in the international area and facilitate its members' pursue of modern and advanced ophthalmology.
